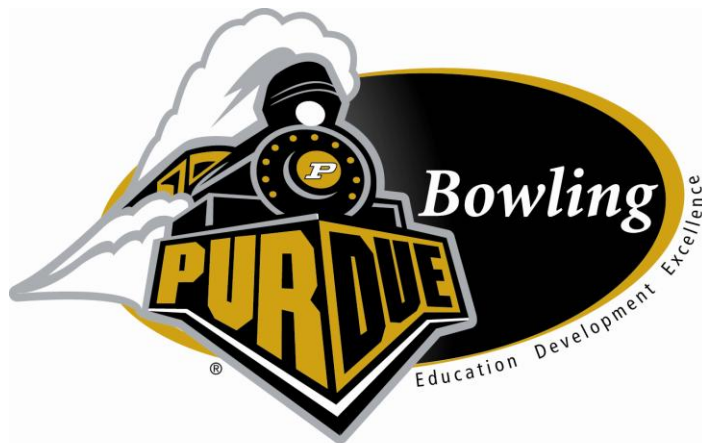

TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY: The tournament is certified by USBC Collegiate and will comply with all USBC rules, regulations, and conduct. All member teams of the USBC Collegiate Bowling Program are eligible to participate. All team members must be eligible according to USBC Collegiate eligibility rules. Entry limited to USBC Collegiate members only.

ENTRIES: Entries are limited to the first 84 teams who enter. Only three (3) teams representing each school in each division may participate. A team entering more than one (1) team in each division must declare a “varsity” team before the start of competition. There are two squads. Teams will maintain squad designation both days. Entries close October 29th at 3:00 pm.

TEAM ROSTERS: A roster may consist of up to eight (8) bowlers. A legal line up must consist of a minimum of five (5) bowlers. If a team has less than 5 bowlers, they will receive a score of zero (0) for that roster spot each game.

FORMAT: This tournament uses a scratch scoring system with separate men’s and women’s divisions. Mixed teams will be placed in the men’s division. Men and women competing on a mixed team shall be included in the men’s all-events standings. The tournament will consist of five (5) standard games, and four (4) four (4)-game Baker matches. Total pinfall for the 5 standard games and 16 Baker games will determine final standings.

AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS: Awards will be presented to the 1st and 2nd place varsity teams in each division as well as for the top five (5) individuals in each division or “All-Tournament Team”. Scholarships or team prize money will not be awarded from team entry fees and if awarded will come from outside sources.

CHECK-IN: Check in time is no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time. At that time, all fees and roster changes must be completed. **Note: No roster changes will be accepted once competition has started.**

DRESS CODE: Teams should attempt to adhere to the Collegiate Bowling dress code as described in the USBC Collegiate Bowling Rulebook for Intercollegiate Team Championship competition.

LANE COURTESY: Teams will be expected to adhere to one (1) lane courtesy.

SUBSTITUTIONS: A player once removed cannot return to bowl for the remainder of the game. A maximum of three substitutions are permitted during each game, only one of which is allowed in the 10th frame.

CONDUCT: Each team must have a school coach, advisor or team captain designated as a team representative. He or she will be responsible for their team's conduct at all times. Inappropriate behavior, as deemed by tournament officers, shall be cause for disqualification after the team has been given one (1) warning. Smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages will not be permitted during competition.

POSITION TIES: In the case of a 1st place tie for the championship, teams will split 1st and 2nd place prize money (if any) and power points.

FINAL STANDINGS: The final results will be forwarded to USBC Collegiate headquarters within ten (10) working days of the completion of the tournament. Final tournament results will be mailed or emailed to all participating programs within thirty (30) days.

TERMINATION CLAUSE: Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the Boilermaker Classic shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR: The tournament director reserves the right to make any rule changes necessary to ensure fair play prior to the start of the tournament.
